


Ice CaveA magical world of ice

Accompanied by experienced cave guides, you can explore the magical underground world of Dachstein. The spectacular **ice sculptures**, breathtaking





Mammut cave

Cave labyrinth of superlatives

One of the largest karst caves in the world impresses with its size, variety of shapes and spectacular artistic installations.

Almost **70 km** of the cave labyrinth has been explored, so where else could you get a better impression of the wide range of shapes of the cave world



than here. Our guided tours will take you through gigantic cave passages, impressive rock cathedrals and explain how they were formed. Interplays of light and shadows and a laser installation add special effects.

At our **trekking tours** you can experience the fantastic underground world. Grab your overalls, head torch and helmet and explore the **"Verfallene Burg"** or the inner of the mountain. An exciting adventure is guaranteed!







Koppenbrüller cave Roaring water

Where a spectacular cave stream plunges into the Koppentraun river, the latest of the three Dachstein caves – the Koppenbrüller cave is located.

Especially during snowmelt and heavy rainfalls you can observe a unique natural spectacle here, which you can **hike through in complete safety** on one







of our guided tours. The water crashes its way through the mountain – no wonder that there are so many myths surrounding this cave. You can explore this "wild" side of the cave in one of the **trekking tours for the whole family.** Take the child-friendly **short adventure tour** or the challenging **trekking tour along the original waterways,** you'll feel like a real explorer!









Dachstein Krippenstein More than just hiking

A wonderful mountain plateau and plenty of variety: Here at the Dachstein Krippenstein you'll find everything a hiker, climber or leisure tourist could want.

The Dachstein Krippenstein cable car will transport you up to approx. 2,000 m, enabling you to conquer







the mountain with no effort at all. There is also disabled access: The **WeltNATURerbeblick** viewing platform is **wheelchair accessible** to ensure that everyone can enjoy the unique Dachstein panorama.



The **Dachstein Shark** (approx. 8-metre) is the latest attraction on the **Heilbronner circular trail.** The popular photo point can be reached in around 30 minutes walking distance and offers visitors a view into the pre-historic past of the Dachstein massif.







The Dachstein A sporting challenge

Heilbronner circular trail

This hiking trail is particulary suited to families. Gentle climbs and incredible views of the Hallstätter Glacier accompany this **family-friendly hiking tour.** Information boards, fossils, the Dachstein Shark and an extensive network of trails make a trip from the mountain station to the "Gjaidalm" educational and enjoyable for young and old.









Need to satisfy your impuls for exercise? Then Dachstein Krippenstein is just your place. All the way from the valley to the top, the region offers delightful **hiking routes**, but also challenging mountain and **climbing tours**, such as the new via ferrata "Dachstein Krippenstein", as well as a **wide range of sports options**. So pack the backpack and set off! No matter if going on a tour across the Dachstein Plateau or a leisurely walk near a lodge – the Dachstein offers plenty of variety at any time of year!



Nature Trail

Those interested in geology will love the Nature Trail. This **themed walk** leads from the "Gjaidalm" via Wiesberghaus lodge to the "Simonyhütte" and provides extensive knowledge about the rocks, plants and animals of the region.





5fingersAdrenaline & Relaxation

Not for the faint-hearted! The 5fingers viewing platform, 400 metres above the abyss, provides a high level of adrenaline rush.

On five differently designed platforms, the **5fingers**, you can check your fear of heights and enjoy unique panoramic views of lake Hallstättersee and



Hiking tips



WeltNATURerbeblick viewing platform

Difficulty: Easy, disabled access, also for wheelchairs! Walking time: 5 minutes. From the mountain station turn right all the way to the WeltNATURerbeblick viewing platform.



Welterbespirale viewing platform

Difficulty: Easy. Walking time: 15 minutes. From the mountain station via the WeltNATURerbeblick viewing platform to the Welterbespirale viewing platform, back via the Heilbronner Chapel.



Difficulty: Easy, accessible by pushchair. Walking time: approx. 25 minutes, return from the 5fingers to the mountain station approx. 30 minutes.

From the mountain station turn right all the way to the WeltNATURerbeblick viewing platform and on to the 5fingers. Short ascent to the turn-off to the Welterbespirale viewing platform, then down to the 5fingers. Tip for the way back: Back to the turn-off for the Welterbespirale viewing platform, visit the Heilbronner Chapel, return to the mountain station or carry on to the Lodge at Krippenstein (Stop-off).



Dachstein Shark

Difficulty: Easy. Walking time: approx. 30 minutes. From the mountain station along the Heilbronner circular trail. The Dachstein Shark is accessible.



Heilbronner circular trail

Difficulty: Medium, mountain walk. Walking time: Approx. 3 hours overall. From the mountain station keep left, down the ski piste. At the signpost, continue following the marked trail

to the left, past the Dachstein Shark you'll reach the Heilbronner Cross in approx. 1.5 hours. From there continue on via Hirzkar to Gjaid Alm Lodge (Stop-off).



Dachstein Nature Trail

Difficulty: Medium, mountain walk. Walking time: from the valley station Gjaid (section 3) and back approx. 6 hours.

The Dachstein Nature Trail leads along the Dachstein mountain plateau and through the Dachstein nature reserve. From the valley station Gjaid to Wiesberghaus lodge (walking time approx. 2 hours), Difference in altitude approx. 140 metres. From Wiesberghaus lodge via the Nature Trail in around 1.5 hours (Difference in altitude 330 metres) to the Simonyhütte lodge. Return same way as up or via the Taubenkar to Gjaid




Hiking trail via Koppenwinklalm to Koppenbrüller cave

Difficulty: Easy. Walking time: 1.5 hours. From the car park of the valley station of the Dachstein Krippenstein cable car along the forest route into the Koppenwinkl nature reserve.

Continue to Koppenwinklalm, via the Koppenwinkllacke to the Koppenrast Inn. from there to Koppenbrüller cave.

Please note!

The Heilbronner Circular Trail and nature trail lead through the high mountains! The weather can change quickly, so it is essential to bring protective gear against the sun, rain and cold, your mobile phone, a small snack and enough to drink! Sturdy hiking or climbing footwear is also required!
